

CITY OF KALAMAZOO Consolidated Plan Community Needs Survey

In order to receive funding from the federal government, the City of Kalamazoo must prepare a five year Consolidated Plan to identify needs in the community which can be addressed through grants from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The plan is designed to guide the City's funding decisions over the next five years. These decisions must take into account the national objectives of these grant programs relevant to the City of Kalamazoo, which are benefiting low- and moderate- income persons and aiding in the prevention or elimination of slums and blight.

Due to the ever decreasing amounts of federal funds received by the City, it is more important than ever that spending be prioritized with the community's unmet needs. To help us understand what is most important, the City has begun with community outreach. The public input received will be evaluated against the data gathered for the Plan; the City's current funding and budget realities; and outside community resources that may already be addressing a need.

The survey includes categories of goals that the City might wish to address in the Consolidated Plan over the next five years. While the survey is intended to be anonymous, the City would like to have a better understanding of who has completed the survey.
